Film Laminating Adds Protection and Durability

Film laminating is a great way to give products the added protection and durability they need to withstand heavy usage. This makes it a great choice for menus, book covers, flip charts and instruction manuals.

At Seaboard Bindery, we offer several laminating films in a variety of finishes to match the needs of your application. Here are some of the most popular choices:

Polyester - Polyester films are noted for their durability and excellent scuff and scratch resistance, making them ideal for all laminating applications. At Seaboard Bindery, polyester laminating films are available in gloss, matte and satin finishes.

Polypropylene - This inexpensive film variety offers a high-gloss finish that's desirable for many applications. Although the softer surface of polypropylene is more easily scratched than other films, it has superior scoring and folding qualities that work well on book cover applications. As with polyester films, polypropylene films are available in gloss, matte and satin finishes.

Nylon - Great for most book cover applications because nylon laminating films lie flatter than either polyester or polypropylene. For this reason, nylon films are ideal for products that will have a long shelf life. Nylon films are also very durable, have excellent scuff/scratch resistance, and are available in gloss and matte finishes.

Glueable/Stampable - These film varieties allow laminated pieces to be foil stamped and embossed for greater design flexibility. Check with us to find out what finishes these films are available in.

Planning Tip: Minimize press powder - Powder buildup on press sheets can compromise the ability of the film to adhere to the sheet, leading to unsatisfactory results. Be sure to remove excess powder once sheets come off press.
