

Laminating: Book Covers and Beyond!

The world of laminating is beautiful and varied. However, just like book binding, DEADLINES and COST are two very important factors impacting your ability to land projects that involve laminating.

Running multiple-up jobs through one-sided film laminating machines usually saves time and money. Not surprisingly, how you impose them on the sheet is very important. For example, your laminating professional must cut apart work & turn and work & tumble layouts before adhering film laminate to paper, which significantly increases product cost and turnaround time. Yes, sheet-wise layouts usually cost printers more in the pre-press and pressroom areas, but these costs often are more than compensated by outsourced finishing savings.

NOTE: When planning multiple-up jobs that must be cut apart prior to laminating, make sure that you provide at least 1/2" margin around ALL image areas.
