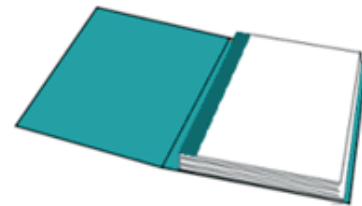

While standard perfect binding is suitable for many annual report applications, PUR binding is ideal for reports printed with full bleeds or contain heavy coatings. If layflat properties and a distinctive appearance are a must on your reports, Otabind, RepKover and Eurobind are optimum solutions.

Although the majority of annual reports are adhesive bound, many companies would like a “high-end” version of the report for distribution to major stockholders.
